## Members With MilWay Debit Cards: YOUR EXISTING DEBIT/ATM CARDS WILL BE DEACTIVATED ON **NOVEMBER 1, 2021.**

We're in the process of replacing current MilWay debit cards with new EMV/Contactless chip cards!

### WHEN WILL MY NEW DEBIT CARD ARRIVE?

Look for your new card in late October.

### WHAT DO I NEED TO DO WHEN MY CARD ARRIVES?

Activate your new card as soon as it is received, destroy your existing non-EMV (chipless) card, and update any recurring payments with your new card number.

### WHAT ABOUT ATM CARDS?

ATM cards will also be reissued at this time, but will not have EMV chips. **Your existing ATM cards will also be deactivated November 1, 2021.**

### WHAT IS AN EMV CHIP-ENABLED CARD?

Your new debit card will come equipped with the latest EMV chip/contactless technology, making your card more secure with encrypted information. Rather than swiping your card, you can either insert your chip card into an EMV-compatible terminal, or use the contactless option to complete a transaction.
